Mission statement

SG/NJ is an international peer-reviewed published three times per year. The SG/NJ uses the Diamond Open Access model. This means that there are NO author processing fees and no fees to access the published papers. In 2017 SG/NJ published about 50 scientific research articles and reviews each year.

SG/NJ permits and encourages authors to post items submitted to the journal on personal websites or institutional repositories both prior to and after publication, while providing bibliographic details the credits, the publication in SG/NJ. Each manuscript is checked for text similarity and manually verified by the editor. We use CrossRef Similarity Check with **Ithenticate** algorithm (<https://www.crossref.org/services/similarity-check/>) and deal with manuscripts suspected on plagiarism following the COPE flowcharts (<http://publicationethics.org/resources/flowcharts>) and ICMJE guidelines.

Nursing journal [NJ], Croatian Nurse Association official publication, is a journal that brings a wide range of topics related to nursing. It is published three times per year. Apart from original scientific and professional papers from nursing and other related disciplines, the journal publishes translated texts, various documents, statistical data, reports, reviews, comments and various information (interviews, reportages) from nursing life. The Nursing Journal [NJ] provides a medium for the publication of high-quality original scientific reports that advances or illuminates nursing, healthcare science or practice and educates or entertains journal's readers. NJ welcomes original articles, brief communications; case reports; editorials; historical pages; review articles; patient's safety; workplace safety; letters to the editor. Papers are subjected to peer review by both the Editorial Board and invited reviewers. Nursing journal's targeted audience are nurses, healthcare and biomedicine professionals and managers interested in continuous quality improvement, total quality management processes, clinical procedures and facilities. Nursing Journal informs its readers about current activities of the Croatian Nurses Association, central and branch offices, professional associations as well as social problems of health care workers with special attention paid to nurses.

The International Editorial Board and Executive Committee encouraged the authors to write articles on English language.
